Pupil Premium analysis for Academic Year 2014-15

(NB Progress measures have changed this year for Key Stage 1 pupils (Y1)- progress measures beginning to be introduced linking with New National Curriculum)

Foundation Stage

- Reading -100% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in Foundation stage (all pupils= 100%)
- Writing -100% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in Foundation stage (all pupils=100%)
- Maths 86% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in Foundation stage (all pupils= 100%)
- 57% of children in receipt of Pupil Premium funding achieved a good level of development at the end of the Foundation Stage.

 This is in line with the cohort as a whole.

Year 1

- Reading Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding made better progress overall than non- Pupil Premium pupils
- - 75% of the eliqible pupils made good or better progress in Year 1(All pupils= 55%)
- Writing Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding made better progress overall than non- Pupil Premium pupils
- - 86% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in Year 1(All pupils= 65%)
- Maths - Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding made better progress overall than non- Pupil Premium pupils
 - 72% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in maths in Year 1(all pupils = 85%)
- 71% of pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding achieved the expected standard in the Y1 phonics screen

Year 2 - End Key Stage 1

- Reading Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding make the same amount of progress overall as non-Pupil Premium pupils
 - 100% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress across Key Stage 1 (All pupils= 97%)
 - -Pupils in receipt of pupil Premium funding attain higher than similar children nationally in reading
- Writing Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding slightly less progress overall than non- Pupil Premium pupils
 - -86% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in writing across Key Stage 1 (all pupils= 97%)

- Pupils in receipt of pupil Premium funding attain higher than similar children nationally in writing
- Maths Pupils in receipt of Pupil Premium funding made similar progress overall as non- Pupil Premium pupils
 - -100% of the eligible pupils made good or better progress in maths across Key Stage 1 (all pupils = 98%)
 - Pupils in receipt of pupil Premium funding attain higher than similar children nationally in maths
