Value of the Month—Equality (including fairness)

Fairness: Impartial and just treatment or behaviour without favouritism or discrimination. Treating people equally or in a way that is right or reasonable.

Equality: the state of being equal, especially in status, rights, or opportunities. Making sure everyone is treated equally and fairly

This is what the children say about Fairness and Equality

- Fairness is treating all people with honesty and respect
- Giving everyone equal chances to do well
- Cooperating with each other
- Respecting our differences
- Making sure others are not treated badly.

We can show Fairness and Equality by:

Children's understanding of Fairness and Equality

The children have been introduced to what fairness and equality means and how they can use this and show it every day in school. They have found out about how to be fair and show equality by putting themselves in others shoes and considering when things are not fair or equal.

Children will learn to consider the feelings of others and the impact of their actions.

This will compliment our work on understanding emotions to support positive attitudes and behaviour.



Fairness and Equality –What the children say



Home learning activities

- Combine maths learning with finding out about sharing - fair shares of sweets—sharing between family members. Discuss fair share.
- More maths links—make piles of coins of the same type — each with the same total value. Discuss the fact that even though the piles are different they all have the same value
- Find a story about equality and fairness and read it at home. Bring it into school to share in your class.
- Play a board game with the family. Make sure everyone is taking turns, playing fairly and with no cheating!
